- 3 year program
- · Prerequisite: Sophomore
- Students will experience design engineering in the creation, synthesis, iteration, and presentation of design solutions.

Automotive

- · 3 Year Program
- Pre-requisite: Sophomore
- Instruction in all nine ASE Educational
 Foundation areas of automotive and light duty diesel. Includes training in workplace readiness, leadership, human relations, safety, and efficient work practices.



Law Enforcement

- · 2 year program
- Prerequisite: Junior
- Police officer, correctional officers, probation officers, dispatchers
- · Prepares them for a POST-certified course
- Academic subjects: Constitutional Law, Criminal Procedures, Idaho Code, FEMA National Incident Management System, Defensive Tactics, Weapons-Handling, ASP Baton, and Handcuffing.
- Students earn FEMA-100, FEMA 700, Stop The Bleed, First Aid, and CPR certifications.

- · 3 year Program
- · Prerequisite: Sophomore
- Will be learning about electrical theory, code compliance, and installation techniques.
- Prepares you for journeyman certification as well as equips you with in-demand skills crucial for a successful electrical career.

Welding

- · 3 year Program
- · Pre-requisite: Sophomore
- Form cutters, tack welders, welder assemblers, welder helpers, combination welders, arc welders, and production line welders as well as providing basic metallurgy knowledge and skills
- Students will study metallurgy science and the basics of heating and treating metals to be used in various applications, including casting, forming, fitting, bending, welding, and hammering.
- Skills learned include: oxyacetylene welding and cutting, Shielded Metal Arc Welding (SMAW), Gas Metal Arc Welding (GMAW), Flux Core Arc Welding (FCAW), Gas Tungsten Arc Welding (GTAW), soldering, certification test preparation, and use of current industry standards and techniques.

- Prepare students for employment as a pharmacy tech.

Diesel | Heavy Equipment

- 3 year program
- Prerequisite: Sophomore
- Heavy equipment/diesel includes instruction in inspection, maintenance, and repair of tracks, wheels, brakes, operating controls, pneumatic and hydraulic systems, electrical circuitry, engines, and in techniques of welding and brazing.
- Training in applied communications, and employability skills including leadership, human relations, and safe efficient work practices.

- Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)
 - 1 year program
 - Prerequisite: Junior or Senior
 - Instruction in anatomy and physiology, airway management, patient assessment, medical and trauma emergencies, CPR, and more.
 - · Opportunity to find a job on an ambulance.
 - Certifications: BLS CPR, Stop the Bleed, National Incident Management System 100 and 700.
- Advanced Emergency Medical Technician (AEMT)
 - 1 year program
 - o Prerequisite: Senior, EMT Program
 - Pharmacology, IV administration and supraglottic airway management skills.
