Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) - Prepares students for employment as nursing assistants in nursing homes, hospitals, and other medical settings.

- 1-Year Program
- Prerequisite: Sophomore

Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)

Prepares students for entry-level careers in emergency medical services and provides a strong foundation for further education in healthcare.

- 1-Year Program
- Prerequisite: Junior or Senior

Advanced Emergency Medical Technician (AEMT)

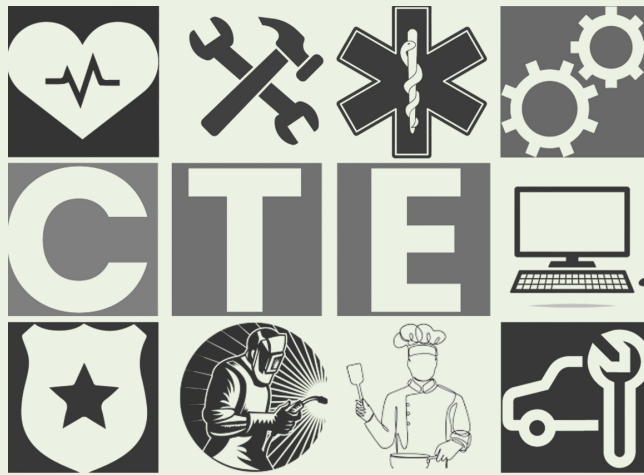
Prepares students for a higher level of emergency medical care than a basic EMT, bridging the gap between EMT-Basic and Paramedic. It equips students with expanded clinical skills and knowledge to manage more complex medical and trauma emergencies in pre-hospital settings

Pharmacy Tech

Prepares students to assist licensed pharmacists in dispensing medications, managing inventory, and supporting the daily operations of a pharmacy.

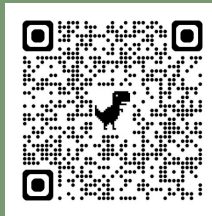

AUTO & DIESEL

Automotive I, II, & III

Prepares students for careers in the automotive service and repair industry by giving them hands-on, real-world skills in vehicle maintenance, diagnostics, and repair. It combines classroom instruction with lab/shop experience to build both technical knowledge and workplace readiness.

- 3-Year Program
- Prerequisites: Freshmen (students will promote levels based on the teacher's recommendation)

Diesel/Heavy Equipment I, II, & III

Prepares students for high-demand careers in the diesel technology and heavy equipment maintenance industries. This program provides hands-on training and foundational knowledge needed to inspect, diagnose, maintain, and repair diesel engines and large machinery used in construction, agriculture, transportation, mining, and logistics.

- 3-Year Program
- Prerequisites: Freshmen (students will promote levels based on the teacher's recommendation)

BUILDING TRADES

Prepares students for careers in the construction industry by teaching them hands-on skills, safety certification, foundational knowledge, and leadership skills needed to work successfully in residential, commercial, and industrial construction settings. Prepares for internships and/or post-secondary education advancement.

- 3-Year Program
- Prerequisite: Sophomore

CULINARY ARTS

Prepares students for careers in the food service and hospitality industry. Students will learn foundational cooking techniques, cold food, baking, kitchen safety, nutrition, front-of-house training, and customer service skills. It also develops professionalism and prepares students for both immediate employment and postsecondary culinary education.

- 3-Year Program
- Prerequisites: Sophomore

PRE-ENGINEERING

Prepares students for careers and postsecondary education in engineering, architecture, robotics, and related STEM fields. It provides a strong foundation in math, science, and problem-solving, while introducing students to real-world engineering tools, technologies, and design processes.

LAW ENFORCEMENT

Prepares students for careers in law enforcement, public safety, and criminal justice by teaching them foundational knowledge, practical skills, and ethical standards required for entry-level roles or continued study in the field.

- 2-Year Program
- Prerequisite: Junior

WELDING

Prepares students for high-demand careers in welding, metal fabrication, and industrial manufacturing by teaching them hands-on technical skills, safety procedures, and industry standards for working with metals and welding equipment.
